

In August 2022, there were totally 25 toys recalled cases from EU Rapex system. As for country of origin, one was from Germany, one was from Belgium, one was from Turkey,one from unknown, the rest were all from mainland of China. A total of three expandable toys have been recalled which expands more than 50% in size when in contact with water. If child puts it in the mouth or swallows it, the contact with saliva or stomach liquids will cause the figurine to expand, which can result in occlusion of the respiratory track or intestinal blockage.

There were 2 recalled cases from US, two were from mainland of China.

There were 2 recalled cases from Canada, two were from mainland of China.

There was 1 recalled case from Australia, which the country of origin was unknown.

5	GROWING SECO	Expandable toy (Unknown)	The egg easily breaks and releases a turtle figurine which expands more than 50% in size when in contact with water. If child puts it in the mouth or swallows it, the contact with saliva or stomach liquids will cause the figurine to expand, which can result in occlusion of the respiratory track or intestinal blockage. 20	SMOOTE TRAIN	Plastic toy (China)	The battery compartment cover can be easily opened (if the toy is dropped), leaving batteries accessible. A child may put them in the mouth and suck on them. 25		Soft toy (China)	Small part (metal zipper) may easily detach from the toy. The fibrous stuffing material of the toy is easily accessible. A small child may put the small part and/or the stuffing material in the mouth and choke. Moreover, the plastic of the packaging is too thin. If a child plays with the packaging, the plastic can cover the mouth and nose, causing the child to suffocate. Furthermore, the battery compartment can be easily opened, leaving the button cell batteries accessible. A child may put them in the mouth and ingest them, which may lead to choking if they enter the airways, or could cause damages to the gastrointestinal tract. 1		Activity desk (China)	The recalled product may pose a jaw entrapment and protrusion hazard when used as a crib toy, when used as a crib toy. When a child's jaw becomes entrapped in a product, there is potential for damage to teeth and gums.	Refund
2		Bear Activity Toy (China)	The mirror can come out of the silicone bear cover if pushed, exposing sharp edges of the mirror, posing a laceration hazard to children.	Refund
